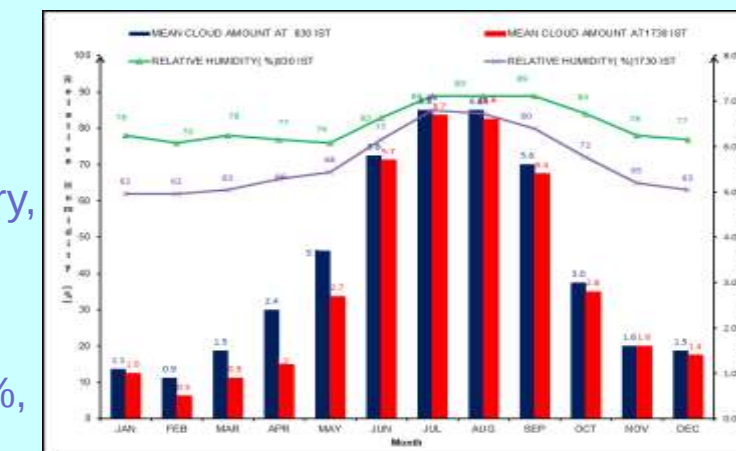
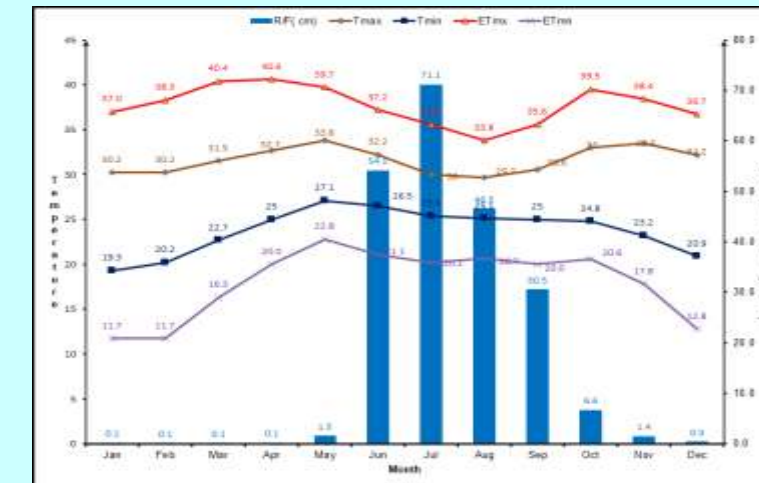




CLIMATE OF CITY - MUMBAI STATE :- MAHARASHTRA, DIST :- MUMBAI

Climate of Mumbai city is characterised by an oppressive summer, dampness in the atmosphere throughout the year and heavy southwest monsoon rainfall.

- » Average annual Maximum Temp. is 31.6°C.
- Average annual Minimum Temp. Is 23.8°C.
- » Mean Maximum Temp. of Hottest Month(May) is 33.8°C.
- Mean Minimum Temp. of Hottest Month(May) is 27.1°C.
- » Mean Maximum Temp. of Coldest Month (January) is 30.2°C.
- Mean Minimum Temp. of Coldest Month (January) is about 19.3°C.
- » Ever Recorded Maximum Temperature was 40.6°C on 19th April 1955.
- Ever Recorded Minimum Temperature was 11.7°C on 1st February 1929 and 15th January 1935.
- » Average annual Rainfall is 212.3 cm.
- Average annual Rainy days are about 73.
- » Mean monthly highest rainfall observed in July is about 71.1 cm.
- Mean monthly lowest rainfall observed in January, February, March and April is about 0.1 cm.
- » Ever recorded Heaviest Rainfall in 24 Hrs is 57.6 cm on 5th July 1974.
- Rainfall during the southwest monsoon season is about 95%, of the annual rainfall.



- » Relative humidity is generally high throughout the year and it ranges from 76% to 89% in the morning and from 63% to 85% in the afternoon.

- Skies are generally heavily clouded to overcast during the southwest monsoon season and moderately to lightly clouded during the rest of the year.
- » Thunderstorms generally occur during the period from April to November and its frequency is more during the period from June to September.
- Fog occurs occasionally during the winter season.
