
- Event Characteristics (Scale, intensity and duration) in Forecast Products

Unusual long Heavy rainfall spell of 29 July-7 August 2021 over western parts of WMP and Eastern parts of E Raj


- Event-Heavy rainfall long spell around 10 days with cumulative 80-120cm




Components of IB assessments of Maharashtra Flood 2021

- Event- 120-180cm in 10days- Heavy rainfall unusual higher and longer spell-Climate extremes)
- Period-14-25 July 2021
- Hazards caused-
- Primary-Flash flood, Land slides, Riverine flood
- Secondary Long term inundation affecting lives further
- A landslide in Talai village in Maharashtra's Raigad <u>district killed 38</u>
 <u>people on Thursday. Heavy rainfall over</u>
- Three separate incidents of landslides in Mahad tehsil, which took place on Thursday, is likely to rise, police said. While 32 bodies were found at one spot in Talai, four others were recovered from another location in Sakharsutarwadi village. Fifteen people have been reportedly rescued so far, but over 30 to 35 more are feared trapped under the debris, officials say.






- A. 15-16 July- SCZ-25.2cm Convective-Start of event with max in 2-3 hours at early morning

- B.17-18- 20-24 cm over Colaba and SCZ with max at 1-3am (occurrence of a VERY INTENSE SPELL over VIKHROLI-CHEMBUR areas of Mumbai in the early hours on Sunday with 20-22cm)
- C. 18-19-8-10 cm- Main Mumbai IMD, but sub-urban SANPADA-19CM, Thane and Ullahsnagar-20-22cm
- D.19-20- Rammandir-21cm, Kalyan 37 and Ullahsnagar-28cm
- 20-21-8-11cm with moderate over the main city IMD stations and Sanpada 11 cm
- 21-22- Mahahlaxmi 14cm, Colaba-10cm, 13-18cm Kalyan and Thane









- Stronger lower level westerly and LOW formation


