

## विपदाकारी मौसम घटनाएँ - 2016

#### 2016 की सबसे चित्रग्राही विपदाकारी मौसम घटनाएँ इस प्रकार थे :

- देश के पूर्वीतर, मध्य एवं प्रायद्वीपीय भागों में उष्ण लहर की स्थितियाँ प्रबल रहीं, जिसके कारण 500 से अधिक लोगों की मृत्यु हुई, जिनमें से 324 तेलंगाना से थी ।
- 2016 की ग्रीष्म मॉनसून के दौरान बाढ़ तथा भारी वर्षा के कारण अधिक संख्या में पशुधन हानि एवं कृषि तथा निजी / सार्वजनिक सम्पतियों के अत्यधिक क्षति होने के अलावा 645 लोगों की मृत्यु हुई ।
- चक्रवाती तूफान (रोआनु) बंगाल की खाड़ी (बीओबी) में अक्षांश 11.0° उ. / देशान्तर 81.0° पू. के पास 0300 यू.टी.सी को 17-22 मई के दौरान विकसित हुआ । मई को बांग्लादेश के दिक्षणपूर्व तट को अक्षांश 22.6° उ. और देशांतर 91.6° पू. के करीब चित्तगोंग (बांग्लादेश) के उत्तर की ओर लगभग 1000 यू.टी.सी को तट को पार किया । 22 मई की सुबह म्यानमार में और नागालैंड और मणिपुर के आसपास कमजोर हो गया । त्रिपुरा में एक व्यक्ति की मृत्यु हो गई ।
- अति प्रचण्ड चक्रवाती तूफान (वरदा) बंगाल की खाड़ी (बीओबी) में अक्षांश 8.5° उ. / देशान्तर 91.0° पू. के पास 0900 यू.टी.सी को 6-13 दिसम्बर के दौरान विकसित हुआ । 12 दिसम्बर को उत्तर तिमल नाडु तट को चेन्नई के करीब 0930 और 1130 यू.टी.सी के बीच अति प्रचण्ड चक्रवाती तूफान के रूप में तट को पार किया और उत्तर तिमल नाडु के करीब अक्षांश 13.0° उ. और देशान्तर 79.9° पू. पर केंद्रित रहा और 13 दिसम्बर 0300 यू.टी.सी. को उत्तर तिमल नाडु और निकटवर्ती दिक्षणी आंतरिक कर्नाटक पर कमजोर हो गया । तिमल नाडु में 33 व्यक्तियों की मृत्यु हो गई ।

इन प्राकृतिक आपदाओं का सारांश प्रेस तथा भारत मौसम विज्ञान विभाग के विविध विवरणों की सूचनाओं पर और मीडिया रिपोर्ट पर आधारित हैं । प्रतिकूल मौसम स्थितियों से प्रभावित क्षेत्रों को ऋतुवार चार मानचित्रों में दर्शाया गया है ।

## **DISASTROUS WEATHER EVENTS OF 2016**

#### The most striking disastrous weather events of 2016 were the following:

- Heat wave conditions prevailed over Northeastern, Central and Peninsular parts of the country and claimed human lives over 500 out of which 324 lives claimed from Telangana.
- During summer monsoon of 2016, floods and heavy rains claimed about 645 human lives apart from loss of large number of livestock and extensive damage to agriculture and public/private property.
- A Cyclonic Storm (ROANU) formed over the Bay of Bengal near Lat. 11.0<sup>o</sup>N/ Long. 81.0<sup>o</sup>E at 0300 UTC during 17-22 May, crossed the southeast coast of Bangladesh near Lat. 22.6<sup>o</sup>N and Long. 91.6<sup>o</sup>E around 1000 UTC of 21<sup>st</sup> May close to the north of Chittagong (Bangladesh) and dissipated over Myanmar and adjoining Nagaland & Manipur on 22<sup>nd</sup> May morning. It took a toll of one person in Tripura.
- A Very Severe Cyclonic Storm (VARDAH) formed over the Bay of Bengal near Lat. 8.5°N/ Long. 91.0°E at 0900 UTC during 6-13 December, crossed north Tamil Nadu coast close to Chennai between 0930 & 1130 UTC of 12<sup>th</sup> December as a Severe Cyclonic Storm & lay centered over north Tamil Nadu near Lat. 13.0°N and Long. 79.9°E and dissipated over north interior Tamil Nadu and adjoining south interior Karnataka on 13<sup>th</sup> December at 0300 UTC. It took a toll of 33 persons in Tamil Nadu.

The summary of these natural hazards is based on various reports of the India Meteorological Department and press information. The areas affected by the adverse weather conditions are depicted season wise on four maps.

शीत लहर : ऋण विचलन सामान्य से 4.5°C से 6.4°C तक ।

तिव्र शीत लहर : ऋण विचलन सामान्य से  $6.4^{\circ}$ C से अधिक ।

(B) तटीय स्टेशन के लिए शीत लहर

जब, न्युनतम तापमान 15°C या कम ।

शीत लहर : न्यूनतम विचलन तापमान -4.5°C या कम ।

शीत लहर : जब न्यूनतम तापमान 4ºC से कम या बराबर है ।

TABLE - II : COLD WAVE 2016

**CRITERIA** 

(A) When; Actual minimum temperature is 10°C or less for plains & 0°C or less for Hilly regions.

Cold wave : Negative departure from normal is 4.5°C to 6.4°C.

Severe cold wave: Negative departure from normal is more than 6.4°C.

(B) Cold Wave for coastal station

When; Minimum temperature 15°C or less.

Cold wave : Minimum temperature departure is -4.5°C or less.

(C) Based on Actual Minimum Temperature (For plain stations only)

Cold Wave: When minimum temperature is less or equal to 4°C.

Severe Cold Wave: When minimum temperature is less or equal to 2°C.

For declaring `Cold Wave', the above criteria should be met at least in two stations, in a met. subdivision, for atleast two consecutive days and it will be declared on the second day.

उष्ण लहर : सामान्य से विचलन  $4.5^{\circ}$ C से  $6.4^{\circ}$ C ।

तिव्र उष्ण लहर : सामान्य से विचलन 6.4°C से अधिक ।

(B) तटीय स्टेशन के लिए गर्मी की लहर

जब, वास्तविक अधिकतम तापमान 37°C या अधिक है।

उष्ण लहर : सामान्य से अधिकतम तापमान विचलन 4.5°C या अधिक ।

(C) वास्तविक अधिकतम तापमान पर आधारित

उष्ण लहर : जब वास्तविक अधिकतम तापमान 45°C या अधिक ।

तिव उष्ण लहर : जब वास्तविक अधिकतम तापमान 47°C या अधिक ।

'गर्मी की लहर' घोषित करने के लिए कम से कम लगातार दो दिनों के लिए एक मौसम-उपखंड के कम से कम दो स्टेशनों में उपर्युक्त मानदंड यदि पूरा हो, तो दूसरे दिन इसे घोषित किया जाएगा।

#### TABLE - III : HEAT WAVE 2016

#### **CRITERIA**

(A) When; Maximum temperature is at least 40°C or more for plains & at least 30°C or more for Hilly station.

Heat wave : Departure from normal is 4.5°C to 6.4°C.

Severe heat wave : Departure from normal is greater than 6.4°C.

(B) Heat Wave for coastal station

When; Actual maximum temperature is 37°C or more.

Heat wave : Maximum temperature departure from normal is 4.5°C or more.

(C) Based on Actual Maximum Temperature

Heat wave: When Actual maximum temperature is greater than or equal to 45°C.

Severe heat wave: When Actual maximum temperature is greater than or equal to 47°C.

For declaring `Heat Wave', the above criteria should be met at least in two stations, in a met. subdivision, for atleast two consecutive days and it will be declared on the second day.
